- 16. **Adoption fees:** \$300 per neutered male & \$200 per female. Due to sugar gliders being colony animals, they must be adopted in pairs.
- 17. **Post-adoption support:** We offer advice on any questions you have and a 30-day refund if the adoption is not successful. We also sell equipment and services such as nail clipping, and safe glider toys.
- 18. Health assurance: All sugar gliders receive a veterinary check-up before adoption.
- 19. **Emergency protocol:** In case of an emergency, sugar gliders will be rushed to an emergency veterinary hospital for immediate care.
- 20. **Special needs and behavioral issues:** Sugar gliders with special needs stay with us and are not adopted out. We equip special cages to handle their needs. Gliders with behavior issues are not adopted out.
