18. **Health assurance:** All sugar gliders receive a veterinary check-up before adoption.
19. **Emergency protocol:** In case of an emergency, sugar gliders will be rushed to an emergency veterinary hospital for immediate care.
20. **Special needs and behavioral issues:** Sugar gliders with special needs stay with us and are not adopted out. We equip special cages to handle their needs. Gliders with behavior issues are not adopted out.
